OCCLUSION DEMYSTIFIED

THE GOAL:

The goal is to offer the aesthetic dentist and ceramic technician enhanced skills for the determination of treatment and occlusal positions for the asymptomatic and the symptomatic patient. Evaluation of the physiological bite position via conventional and high tech methods will be discussed. Occlusion stabilization and equilibrium for candidates of extensive aesthetic treatments will be the major focus.
